35.26 ANNOUNCEMENTS

41.26 ESTATES AND ENVIRONMENT

The Clerk informed members that a large branch had fallen at the parish churchyard and had been dealt with quickly. There was no damage caused.

The three yearly tree surveys were being done this month. They cover the Recreation Ground, Newton Green and the Parish Churchyard.

The Clerk was asked to see how much it would cost to have matching railings put in at Church Road Cemetery to cover the frontage not behind railings.

The Clerk had been informed that a boat had been stolen from the river opposite the Harvester. There is no other information about it.

The overgrowing hedge going up Crimp Hill was reported again to RBWM.

The Chair told members that we will be offering the Hub as a data collection point for any information about the ongoing crimes involving catapults.
